KOOGA ENFORCER LITE

A basic scrum sled version of the KooGa Enforcer is also available. The KooGa Enforcer Lite has the same hydraulic transport wheel system and manoeuvrability as the KooGa Enforcer but does not have the mechanical brake and roller system. The machine is manufactured from 50mm RHS with a 5mm wall thickness which gives the KooGa Enforcer Lite more weight than its competitors without extra bulk. The KooGa Enforcer Lite also features a 5mm checkerplate floor and is hot dip galvanised with removable pads.

The KooGa Enforcer scrummaging machine is arguably the most efficient and effective scrum machine available and it is used by many leading rugby union teams including The Wallabies, The ACT Brumbies, Eastwood Rugby Club ACT, Wests Rugby Club ACT, Sydney University and North Sydney Rugby Club.

Originally designed by Ewen McKenzie and the ACT Brumbies, The KooGa Enforcer simulates a live scrum more realistically than any other scrum machine and is distinguished from its competitors by its quality engineering and construction.

GREATER MANOEUVRABILITY ON FIELD

Fitted with a hydraulic raising and lowering wheel system, the KooGa Enforcer enables both forwards and backs to train together at different positions on the field. It also allows the machine to be retrieved and stored with minimal effort.



IDEAL VANTAGE POINT COACHING

From the seat in the body of the machine the operator/coach can spot any faults in the forwards scrum technique.

SCRUMMAGING TECHNIQUE TRAINING

The KooGa Enforcer teaches front rowers to use the correct muscles to direct energy straight ahead, not up and down.



REAL SCRUMMAGING MOTION

Featuring a unique mechanical disc brake and twin roller system, operated by two independent brake levers and controlled by the operator/coach. The KooGa Enforcer can wheel or counteract the wheel by regulating the braking pressure on either of the two independent rollers. These rollers are imperative for realistic scrum simulation and are featured only on the KooGa Enforcer.



MAIN OVAL SAFETY

Due to the brake and twin roller system, the KooGa Enforcer will not tear up the field, and can be safely used on a club's main oval. Inferior single roller brake systems do not allow the outside of the roller to spin faster than the inside of the roller, resulting in damage to the ground



QUALITY ENGINEERING & CONSTRUCTION

Beware of inferior imitations featuring a single roller brake - the KooGa Enforcer is the original and only sled on the market with a twin roller brake system and twin independent brake resistance that can be controlled and adjusted in seconds by the operator from his seat via the two independent brake levers.



Weighing 480kg and measuring approx. 2m square, the KooGa Enforcer is more compact and versatile than any comparable machine on the market and is easily transported or broken down into modules for export. It is built with fabricated frame using heavy wall RHS and 5mm checker plate floor for extra weight, strength and longevity. The body is hot dip galvanised with removable pads and the rollers are manufactured with an off-set spike system for extra traction and minimal damage on the wettest surface.
